The ice rink is open from Monday to Saturday 4pm to 7pm and Sunday 3pm to 6pm, on Tuesday till 9pm.

Entrance fee : 2.00€ - 2.50€ or free with Visalp Skpass.

Sledge slope

80 meters long - great sledging!!

Snow shoes

Tuesday and Thursday afternoons, a local guide, Alain, proposes different walks and Wednesday evening a walk in the moonlight !

Climbing wall

Free entry, bring your own equipment. Ask for the keys at the Tourist Office.

Ice caves

At 2 700 meters, with easy access by the DMC lift, visit the ice caves, the theme this winter is the Ancient Greeks.

Excursions at 2 000 meters (on the piste-basher)

Discover frozen lakes, icefalls and high mountain peaks, fabulous scenery.

Tuesday 22nd December

Night relay race for ski mountaineers.
An exciting race for teams.

Thursday 24th December
