Welcome to your base camp.

Oz 3300 enjoys a prime location for taking on some of the most famous Alpine passes, while returning to the comfort of your accommodation at the end of the day.

Close to iconic cycling routes, especially those of the Tour de France, you can tackle: the 21 bends of Alpe d'Huez, the Croix de Fer and Glandon passes, the Galibier pass, the Sabot pass...



Enjoy a refreshing adventure

Head out for canyoning in Oz and cool off as you descend the Roubier torrent.

With natural slides, jumps of varying heights, and rock pools, this canyon is perfect for thrill-seekers looking for a fun and refreshing experience



Escape for a night at Refuge de la Fare

Nestled at 2,280 metres facing the Belledonne massif, this authentic and welcoming refuge hosts hikers and mountaineers seeking adventure.

This experience offers a true return to basics: watching sunrise or sunset, enjoying a homemade blueberry tart, and observing mountain wildlife, marmots, chamois, ibex, and majestic birds of prey.

From Lake Besson to routes near Refuge de la Fare, in summer or winter (with ice climbing), scale a wide variety of natural cliffs in a stunning setting.

You can also discover the Bernard Fabre climbing hall, located beneath the Tourist Office.

Ride the slopes



From Oz, enjoy direct access to the Alpe d'Huez mountain bike area.

In a spectacular setting of forests, alpine meadows, and high-altitude views, the domain offers 333 km of marked trails, accessible with or without lifts.

A wide variety of routes for all MTB disciplines: downhill, enduro, cross-country, and freeride.

Find your way



Five permanent orienteering courses start from Oz Village, Oz resort, or the lakes plateau, with fun and cultural versions available.

The goal: use natural and man-made features to navigate and find checkpoints.

Experience nature, fully immersed !

Outdoor activities, nature exploration, and fun events bring summer to life and let you experience the mountains differently, more alive, closer, more vibrant.
